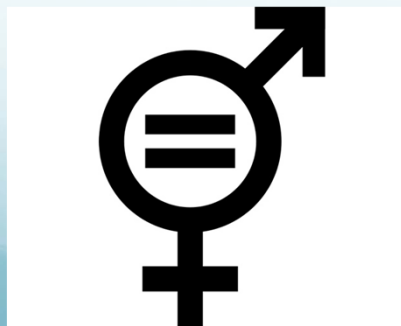

Men and women could be equal when:

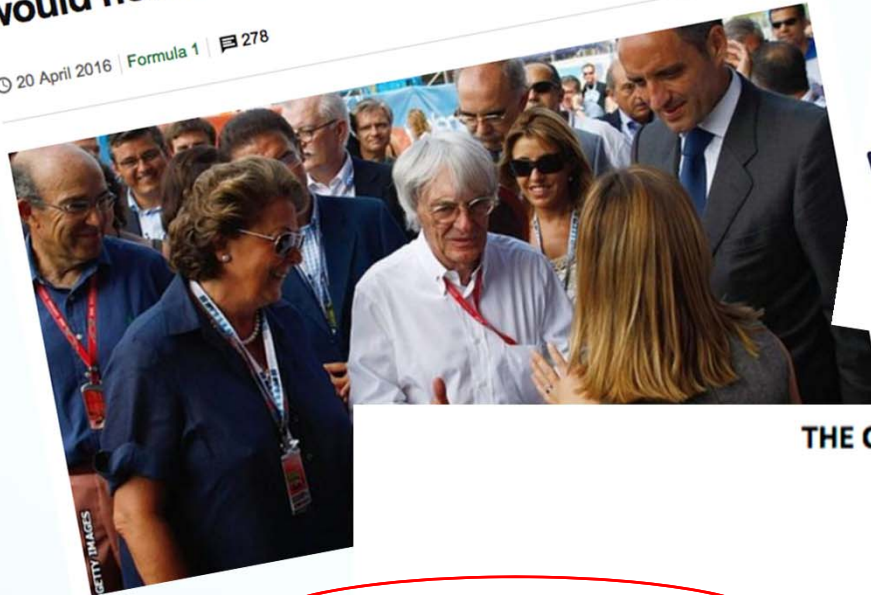
- They have the same salary

Gender

- Physical differences exist
- Some sports may suit genders competing against each other (Precision Sports: Archery, Shooting etc.)
- Others may not due to increased risks of injury or inability to physically compete with each other (Combat Sports: Boxing, MMA etc.)
